TERMS AND CONDITIONS

KING'S TEIGNTON RAM ROASTING FAIR – 26th May 2025

Please note that these Terms and Conditions apply to EVERYONE.

ALL Stallholders, Entertainers and Catering Providers.

A Risk Assessment must be carried out by the person responsible for each stall. Compliance with all relevant legislation, must be the Responsibility of each Stallholder/Provider.

Any insurance cover required is the responsibility of the Stallholders/Service Providers.

The double gates from the Lidl Car Park on to Oakford Lawn will be opened up for vehicular access at 8am. **NO VEHICULAR ACCESS** after 10.45 (excepting Emergency vehicles). From 9am until 6pm the Lane in from Oakford will not be available for vehicles.

Any Stallholder with an essential vehicle having to remain on site during the day, for whatever reason, must make the Committee aware when they apply for their stall and give details of that vehicle with their payment when their stall allocation is confirmed. Unauthorised vehicles must be removed from the Lawn before 11am and will not be permitted to return until 5pm.

No vehicle movements at all will be allowed from 11am until 5pm. This is to ensure the safety of the 4,000+ visitors attending the event during the day. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Anyone seen to be in breach of this rule will be stopped and will not be invited to return if the Fair continues in future years.

Any Stallholder needing to use a generator must make the Committee aware when they apply for their stall. "Silent" generators should be used if the need for them is unavoidable. Please ensure that you have adequate equipment and expertise for both the generator and its fuel supply in the event of a fire.

A site safety inspection will be carried out between 11am and 11.45am prior to the public being admitted to the Lawn.

There should be no trading until the public are allowed in at 11.45am

All waste and rubbish produced as a result of your attendance is your responsibility and must be removed by yourselves from the Lawn. It should not be deposited in the waste bins around the Arena which are provided for use by individual visitors or in the Ram Fair skip.

Any single use plastic products should be avoided wherever possible.

King's Teignton Ram Roasting Fair Committee takes no responsibility for loss of Stallholder/Service providers profits, or the return of pitch fees, in the event that the 2025 Fair is cancelled because of severe weather conditions, or for any other safety reason on the preceding days or the day of the Fair itself.
